Appalachian Outreach Inc. will be available for used furniture, toys, bikes and other household items.

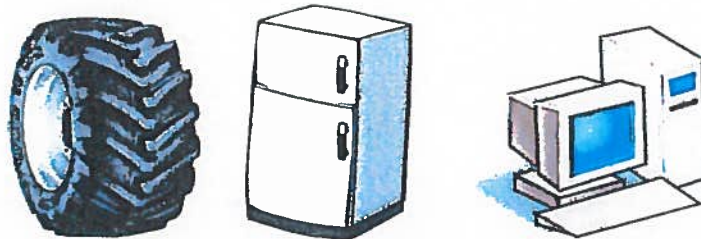
